The Point of Contact of the Espoo Convention in
Estonia

Consultation in accordance with Articles 4 and 5 of the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention) for the Estonian project to construct the pier to Pakrineeme Sadama of the Paldiski LNG terminal.

In a letter dated 9 January 2014, Estonia notified Finland according to the Espoo Convention of the Estonian project to construct a pier to Pakrineeme Sadama of the Paldiski LNG terminal. Finland indicated a wish to participate in the EIA procedure.

Estonia has sent Finland the results of the EIA in accordance with Articles 4 and 5 of the Espoo Convention in a letter dated 16 April 2015. According to the documentation project concludes that there will be no significant transboundary impacts outside Estonian territory. The Ministry of the Environment distributed the consultation material for comments and no statements were received.

Based on the EIA documentation, and reflecting its own views, the Ministry of the Environment is of the view that the transboundary environmental impacts of the project will not be significant in Finland and therefore the Ministry does not have any more comments.
