Outcome of proceedings

1. Approval of the agenda

The Presidency welcomed all participants and drew their attention to the agenda in document CM 4108/19 and explained the idea to go through the document 12499/19 before lunch and prepare next version for discussions for the afternoon.

2. Circular Economy on Construction

The Member States analyzed Draft Council Conclusions – Circular economy on construction (document 12499/19). A second reading of the draft Council conclusions was done during the morning and the Member States delivered their wishes for elaborations in writing before breaking for lunch. During the lunch break the Presidency prepared a new afternoon version of the document. The new document was discussed and many elaborations to that document were made in situ during the discussions and some of the elaborations were left to the Presidency for further development.

The Presidency will deliver the elaborated document through Delegates Portal as soon as possible for written consultation for the Member States. Member States were invited to send their written contributions on that document (13270/19) by Wednesday 23rd of October. The Presidency will not accept any new openings to be added to the text. The Member States are encouraged to focus on the **bold and underlined** elaborations in doc. 13270/19.

The Presidency plans to deliver the following compromise version of the Council Conclusions through Delegates Portal on 29th of October.

The next and the last WP will take place on 5th of November. The Presidency aims for consensus for the Council Conclusions and therefore all Member States are urged to consider their positions. The file is expected to proceed to Coreper on 13th November and to the Competitiveness Council on 28th or 29th of November.
